Launched as SS Claude B. Kitchin, hull No.3139. May, 24, 1945 Built by J.A. Jones Construction Co. at Panama City, FL. Commissioned USN: March 5, 1955 at Charleston, SC. as U.S.S. Lookout YAGR-2. On September 28, 1958 her classification was changed to AGR-2

Decommissioned: July 12, 1965 at Bayonne, NJ Sold to Spanish shipbreakers, November, 1970

This logo for Lookout, was designed by John Draves while serving aboard the Lookout. It is one of three that I have located.



U.S.S. Interceptor AGR-8

Launched as SS Edward W. Burton, hull NO. 3147. September 12,1945. Built by J.A.Jones Construction Co. at Panama City, FL Commissioned USN: February 15, 1956 at Charleston, SC. as U.S.S. Interceptor YAGR-8. On September 28, 1958 her classification was changed to AGR-8. Decommissioned: July 1, 1965 Presumed sold and scrapped
