So praying all goes well and soon this pandemic loses its control over our lives and our plans. Stay safe and healthy and safe travels to all.



Jerry Polizzi, USS Outpost, 1960-62

I found Joe Walsh's well written sea story about his unfortunate experience under Captain Queeg on the USS Searcher both hilarious and sad. I served as a new ensign on the USS Outpost during the same period, 1960-62, and had exactly the opposite experience. I had the good fortune of having LCDR Frank Horn as skipper, and LT George Thompson as XO. I found them both to be excellent leaders, managers, sailors, and all around highly professional officers whom I was proud to salute. Wardroom morale could not have been better. Captain Horn encouraged me to "ship over" and went so far as to get me shore duty orders to Naples, would you believe. In hindsight, I foolishly chose not to accept them, preferring to ship out on my Third Mates license (a graduate of SUNY Maritime College) simply to "make money". I did, however, stay in the reserves for 19 more years and retired as a LCDR.

During the Cuban Crisis the east coast ships participated in the United States response to Russia placing nuclear weapons in Cuba. As a result the ships and personnel onboard were awarded 2 medals. The Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal and the Navy Expeditionary Service Medal. AGR 1,2,3,4,9,10,11&12 were given the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal. The Navy Expeditionary Service Medal was also given to AGR-10. It was the only ship to receive this medal.

Over the years I have been asked how qualified members could get their medals. Because of the passage of time and the time involved wading through the beauracratic process I was not to encouraging about trying to get the medal(s). I suggested buying one on the open market. While probably not the correct way to do it, it was the easiest and most practical; and the one I recommend.

Awhile back I received a catalog which listed almost all the medals ever awarded. Includeding the medals above.

If any one wants to get their medal you can ask for a catalog or go online for them They cost from \$11.00 \$16.00. They also have other military memorabilia.
